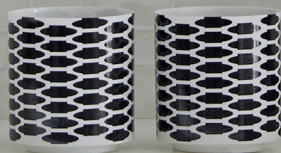

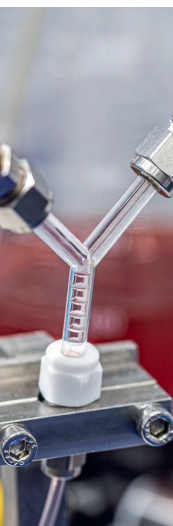

### Dear readers!
